## Description

The ACPL-W60L/K63L are optically coupled gates that combine a GaAsP light emitting diode and an integrated high gain photo detector. The output of the detector IC is an open collector Schottky-clamped transistor. The internal shield provides a guaranteed common mode transient immunity specification of 15  $kV/\mu s.$ 

This unique design provides maximum AC and DC circuit isolation while achieving LVTTL/LVCMOS compatibility. The optocoupler AC and DC operational parameters are guaranteed from  $-40\,^{\circ}\text{C}$  to  $+85\,^{\circ}\text{C}$  allowing trouble-free system performance.














#### **Recommended Solder Reflow Thermal Profile**




Figure 1. Typical high level output current vs. temperature.




Figure 2. Typical input threshold current vs. temperature.




Figure 3. Typical low level output voltage vs. temperature.




Figure 4. Typical low level output current vs. temperature.




Figure 5. Typical input diode forward characteristic.





Figure 6. Test circuit for  $t_{\text{PHL}}$  and  $t_{\text{PLH}}$ .






Figure 7. Typical propagation delay vs. temperature.

Figure 8. Typical pulse width distortion vs. temperature.




Figure 9. Test circuit for common mode transient immunity and typical waveforms.
